Doreen has heard back from the Human Rights Special Program Renewal via email. They are reviewing our application for renewal and this will typically take 30-90 day.

Aboriginal Education

Doreen explained that SD28 (CSS & McNaughton) are undergoing an audit right now, which does involve Aboriginal Education as well. Doreen has put many hours into creating a binder for the auditors – What we do and have done within our department. The binder was received with well remarks.

Community & District Updates

?Esdilagh:

There will be drum making and Healthy Relationship with children in the next month. Otherwise fairly quiet.

Métis:

They have a new board of directors. Otherwise fairly quiet after Christmas.

Friendship Centre:

Drum making – January 30 & 31 from 1-3, call Amy at 250.983.4626. There will be a bannock making contest February. The last Friday of every month from 11-2 is the Elders Circle. Some of the FC bylaws will be changing. During the cold weeks the hall will be used as a warming centre form 9-5 with the staff from Seasons House running the centre.

Trustee:

There is a board meeting tonight. Changes from the Ministry regarding Aboriginal Councils are coming in the near future. SD28 Aboriginal Council is ahead of most districts, and the Ministry will be using our district and another as examples of functioning/well run council

Lhtako/Red Bluff:

Looking into taking some students to Gathering Our Voices in Victoria. We have some of our youth in counselling and are connecting. There is skiing scheduled for our students. The office is back to their regular hours after the cold weather. Youth groups are held ever Tuesday and Thursday from 4-7 all youths ages 14-17 are welcome to attend. Will be taking some student to a 1 day Pow Wow on Jan 26th in WL at Columneetza Jr School. The grand opening of the Arbor and Pow Wow will be on the 1st weekend of August at the new site. Ron R is back to work after a health scare. Volunteers are still needed for the Lhtako Winter Games.

?Echan:

Thelma is trying to gather all the Urban/Off Reserve youth within the community and help teach the culture and be a mentor. This will be offered twice per week from 4-6/7pm. Pick up and drop off is available if needed. The Daycare is booming. The afterschool program is seeing lots of students attend. Thelma is helping support families with the MCFD/medical/water forms/travel arrangement etc.
